Dear Friends,  
 Jesus in today's Gospel tells the parable of the three servants and how they dealt with the talents given to them. Perhaps it is just a coincidence that our word "talent," which means a gift or skill, is used in this story to refer to a very large amount of money—but the connection works for us. As we continue our prayer together today, this may be a good time to reflect on the talents that we have been given and how we have used them in the service of God's reign.  
**THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON:** Our first reading introduces us to a woman of extraordinary skills, who uses her gifts both at home and out in the world, where she reaches out her hands to the poor. When we listen to the Gospel that follows, we can more easily visualize how God expects us to use the talents we have been given, not just to enrich ourselves or our employers, but to make the world a better place.  
**STEWARDSHIP:** The silver pieces of this story stand for a great deal besides money. All temporal and spiritual goods are created by and come from God. That is true of everything human beings have: spiritual gifts like faith, hope, and love; talents of body and brain; cherished relationships with family and friends; material goods; the achievements of human genius and skill; the world itself. One day God will require an accounting of the use each person has made of the particular portion of these goods entrusted to him or her. Each will be measured by the standard of his or her individual vocation.  
**A REMINDER:** As we prepare for our celebrations of Thanksgiving (see schedule for days and times) let us be filled with grateful hearts for all the bountiful gifts God has bestowed upon us. For our God is gracious and good bestowing upon us His Love and Grace.  
**A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK:** How am I investing those talents entrusted to me by the Master?

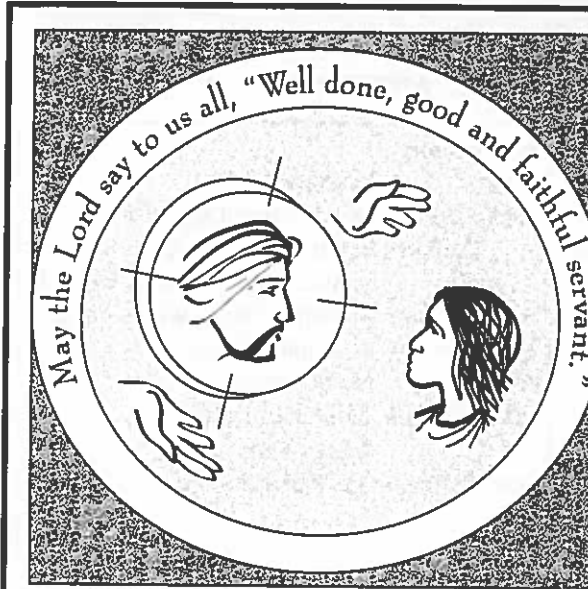
The Shrine will be hosting the Way of Lights from Nov. 17 to Dec. 31 from 5-9 pm. This is a fun family event with many activities.

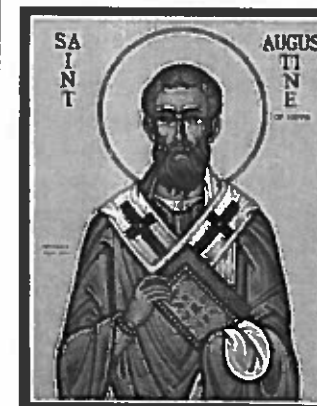
**Reconciliation:** Seasonal penance services offered throughout the year, on Saturday at 3:30 pm at St. Augustine Church or by appointment at any time.

We invite everyone 18 or older to register at the office as adults.

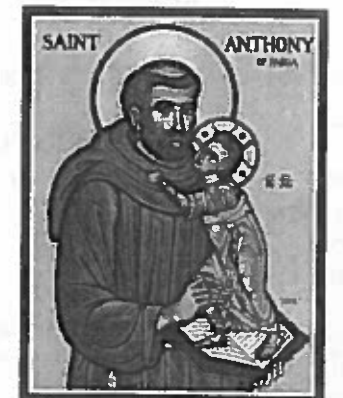
