Dear Friends,
Often when we think of Christ with his title of "King" we think about the Last Judgment. At our celebration today we will indeed hear about Christ at the end-times. Yet the purpose of our gathering here is not to become fearful about what is to come, but rather to support one another in the tasks at hand, encouraged by our good and faithful Shepherd. This way, when judgment time comes, we can be ready and rejoice over the good deeds that have built up God's kingdom.
THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: Today's reading from Ezekiel is the perfect setup for the Gospel. In conclusion, the Lord God promises to judge between the sheep and the goats. That is where the Gospel story picks up. By what standard does the Son of Man judge? By whether we engaged in the corporal works of mercy! The Year of Mercy ended three hundred sixty-five days ago, but we must always remember to be merciful to our sisters and brothers.
STEWARDSHIP: God's kingdom already is present in history, imperfect but real. In Christ, God has entered fully into human life and history. A Christian steward builds God's kingdom in continuity with this present life through the human goods and worthy human purposes. The steward has absolute trust that God will perfect human goods and bring about the final fulfillment of human persons.
A REMINDER: We have reached the end of our Ordinary Time and celebrate Christ as King of the Universe. May He be enthroned in our hearts. Let us now prepare for the awesome Season of Advent. Wednesday of this week, November 29, is First Reconciliation for our Second Graders. Keep them in your prayers.
A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK: Having myself been found by divine mercy, what will I do during Advent to seek those in need? Are they already right here in front of me?

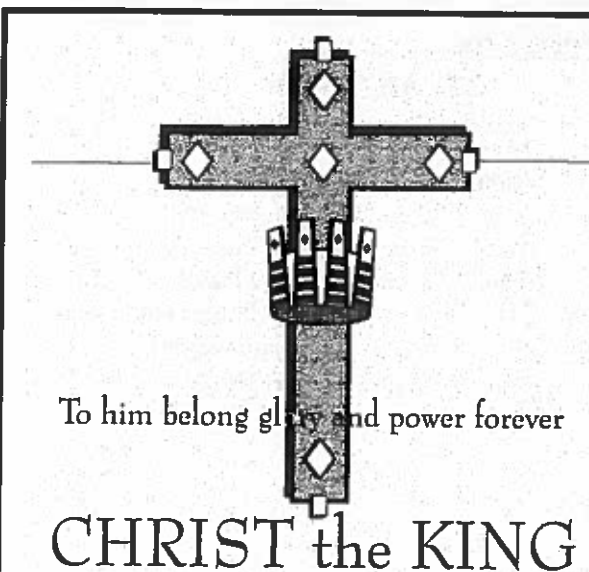

Baptism: Celebrated after the weekend Liturgies by appointment. Baptismal preparation class required. Contact the parish office to register.

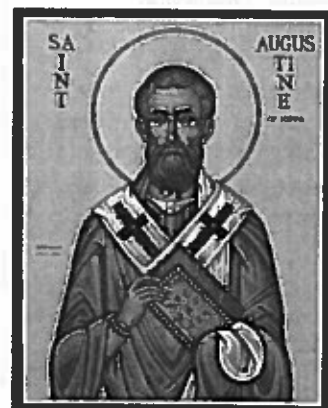
Reconciliation: Seasonal penance services offered throughout the year, on Saturday at 3:30 pm at St. Augustine Church or by appointment at any time.

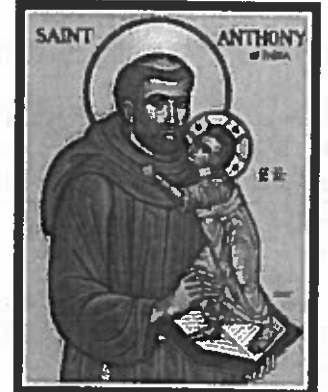
