Dear Friends.

Both today and next Sunday the Gospel readings describe Jesus calling his disciples. In today's passage from John, John the Baptist leads two of his disciples to Jesus. Jesus invites them to follow him and they do, choosing not only to remain with him but also to invite others in turn. In the first reading, Samuel is called to serve the Lord and he too responds affirmatively. Each one provides an example to us today.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: Two of the readings today involve a call from the Lord. Samuel awakens to a summons from God, though it takes a few attempts and some advice from Eli in order to respond appropriately. The first disciples follow Jesus after John the Baptist points him out, "Behold the Lamb of God." These are the same words we hear before Communion. The Lord continually calls to us. How do we respond?

STEWARDSHIP: Today we hear Samuel respond eagerly, "Here I am!" each time the Lord calls him. May we, too, be listening for the call of God in our lives and be ready to say like Samuel, "Speak, for your servant is listening."

A REMINDER: As we begin the Christian Week of Unity on January 18, we will be hosting the Ecumenical Prayer Service at St. Anthony on Thursday, January 18, at 7pm. All are welcome to come and pray for Christian unity. Fellowship will follow in the St. Anthony Parish Center.




