

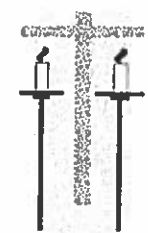

Dear Friends,  
Mark tells the story of the calling of the first disciples in today's Gospel. Jesus asks them to follow, to be sure, but he also tells them that they will become "fishers of men," that they will be asked to share the Good News with others. As we gather today let us think about how we share our faith with others through what we say and what we do.  
**THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON:** There is an urgency in today's readings. Nineveh will be destroyed if the people do not repent within forty days. Saint Paul tells the Christian community in Corinth that "time is running out." Jesus proclaims, "This is the time of fulfillment. The kingdom of God is at hand." Deadlines can inspire us to action. As we listen to the readings today, imagine how the folks addressed by Jonah, Paul, and Jesus responded to this urgency.  
**STEWARDSHIP:** St. Paul's comments are the perfect introduction to how we should approach this year as faithful Stewards. We are all called to work in the world without getting caught up in the cares and concerns of the world. We are called to possess lightly, to manage our affairs prudently without forgetting that we own nothing. It all belongs to God.  
**A REMINDER:** As we commemorate the 45th Anniversary of the Supreme Court's decision to legalize abortion on January 22nd, let us pause and remember the millions of unborn children who were never given the Right to Life and ask God's forgiveness upon our Nation for this atrocious and inhumane sin against Him and against Life. Jesus, have mercy on us.  
**A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK:** How do I live my life as a disciple of Jesus? Do I share the good news through my words and actions?

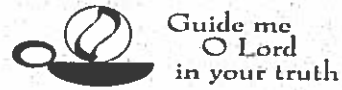

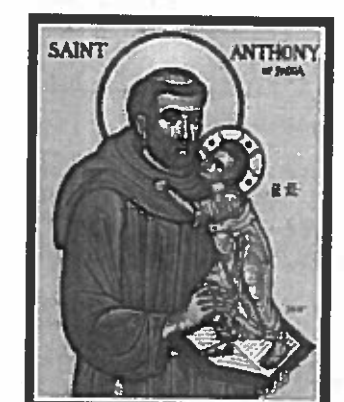
