Dear Friends,
Today we reach the high point of the Christian year: Easter Sunday. Christ is risen! Jesus' mission is complete. Just as Jesus had promised would happen, God raised him up on the third day. Jesus has redeemed us and has given us the hope of eternal life. Today we will renew our baptismal promises, rejecting sin and acknowledging the acceptance of our faith. Let us die to sin so that we can live in new life.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: Today we listen to leaders in the early church as they bear witness to what they saw and what they realized after Jesus rose from the dead. Peter testifies to Jesus' life, death, and resurrection, while Paul advises his audience how to live differently now that Christ is risen. In the Gospel, John tells us of the beloved disciple who, even before he completely understood, saw the empty tomb and the discarded burial cloths and believed.

STEWARDSHIP: As Christians we celebrate God's gift of life for us. We are called to open our hearts, to take responsibility for our God-given gifts, and to share the joy of life with others. Then we will experience a new way of life ... Stewardship.

A REMINDER: A Blessed Easter to each and every one of you and your loved ones. We welcome our newest members who were received into the Church on Holy Saturday: Jeremy Pate from St. Anthony and Aleksandr Sopiars from St. Augustine; keep them in your prayers. There will be Easter Egg hunts for the children following the 9:00 am Mass (St. Anthony) and 10:30 am Mass (St. Augustine). With my responsibilities at Mater Dei, I will be attending the National Catholic Education Association Conference in Cincinnati this coming week.

A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK: How can I bear witness to the Good News of Jesus Christ in the world today? Can I take the risen Christ I receive in the Eucharist and make him present in my daily life?

Baptism: Celebrated after the weekend Liturgies by appointment. Baptismal preparation class required. Contact the parish office to register.

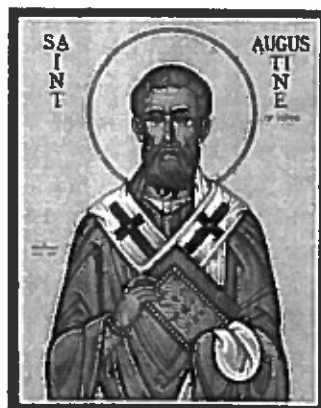
Reconciliation: Seasonal penance services offered throughout the year, on Saturday at 3:30 pm at St. Augustine Church or by appointment at any time.
