Dear Friends,  
A month ago we received ashes on our foreheads as Lent began. We may have chosen to give up something or to do something special during this penitential season. Where do we stand now with that commitment we made? Have we slid back into our old ways from time to time? Have we totally forgotten about it? Well, it's not too late. Always the Lord is calling us to follow him, no matter what has come before.

**THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON:** In the first reading, Jeremiah preaches the new covenant, when the law of the Lord is internalized and written upon the hearts of all who believe. With a new heart, we will have knowledge and obedience of God's will. John describes this knowledge and obedience in Jesus, who realizes that, like the grain of wheat, he must die to this world in order to produce much fruit. It is fitting then, to ask God in the responsorial psalm, "Create a clean heart in me ... and a willing spirit sustain in me."

**STEWARDSHIP:** When Jesus asked his disciples to follow Him, He asked them to give up all they had and leave their families to be disciples. Today, Jesus is not asking us to give up all we possess, but He does ask us to offer what we possess to our brothers and sisters. Putting God first in all areas of our life, enables us to truly be God's servants. Becoming disciples of Jesus Christ leads naturally to the practice of stewardship.

**A REMINDER:** As we celebrate St. Patrick's Day this weekend, let us remember all of our ancestral roots and give thanks for the diversity of our heritage and be grateful that our families who immigrated to this great land found opportunities and gained success. We will be celebrating the Third Scrutiny and Presentation of the Lord's Prayer with our Catechumens (Jeremy Pate at St. Anthony and Aleksandr Sopiars at St. Augustine) at both parishes this weekend.

**A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK:** When I forgive someone who hurt me, do I truly forget it or does it continue to affect our relationship? How can I let go of the injury? How can I be confident that forgetting it will help?

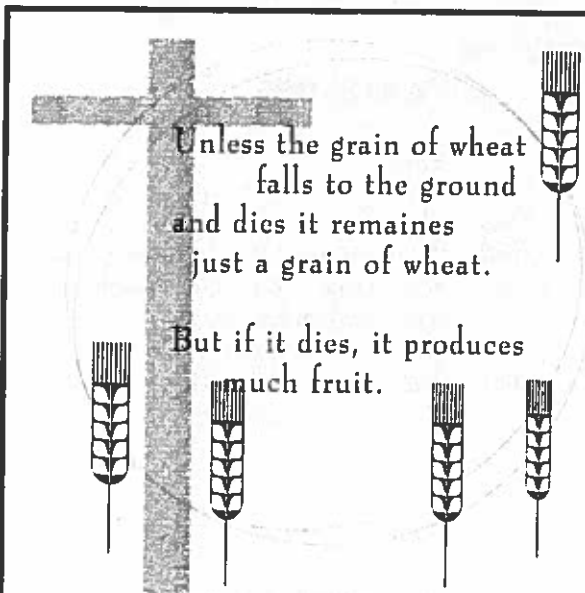

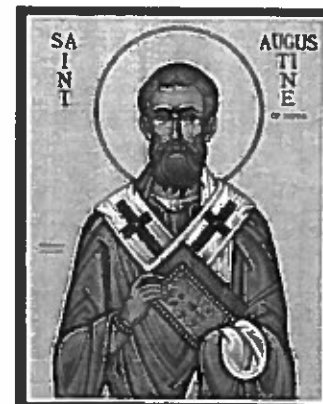
**Reconciliation:** Seasonal penance services offered throughout the year, on Saturday at 3:30 pm at St. Augustine Church or by appointment at any time.
