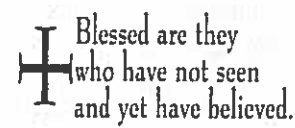

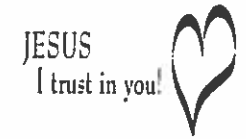

Dear Friends,
Divine Mercy Sunday was officially established in 2000 by Pope John Paul II to be celebrated each year on the Octave Day of Easter, the eighth day of Easter. Today we rejoice in the gift of God's mercy that Jesus offered to the whole world through his cross and resurrection. Let us thank God for that mercy and pray for the grace to extend that mercy to one another.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: "Peace be with you." Three times the newly risen Jesus greets the ones he loves with these words. It is both his greeting and his wish. Today we get a glimpse of the early church, the close-knit community who were "of one heart and mind," sharing what they had so that no one was in need. Let us be of one heart and mind ourselves, merciful and generous, as we extend greetings and wishes to our neighbor: "Peace be with you."

STEWARDSHIP: We celebrate our unity with each other through the sharing of our gifts. Through Eucharist, Christ's love - indeed, His very Self - flows into us, His disciples today, and through us, and our practice of Stewardship, to the entire human race. We are called to be Stewards of the Church today.

A REMINDER: As we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday, we will chant the Divine Mercy Chaplet before the Masses this weekend. We welcome the Breese Knights of Columbus Council 2869 members to our Mass on Saturday evening as they celebrate the 75th Anniversary of the establishment of the Breese Council. Baptism: Celebrated after the weekend Liturgies by appointment. Baptismal preparation class required. Contact the parish office to register.

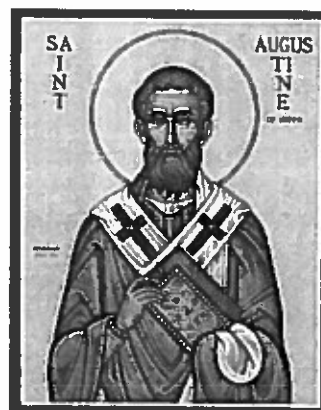
Reconciliation: Seasonal penance services offered throughout the year, on Saturday at 3:30 pm at St. Augustine Church or by appointment at any time.
