

Dear Friends.

In today's Gospel Jesus addresses us with comforting words today: "Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest." Let those words wash over us and all the responsibilities we have, all the stresses we're under, and all the failures that haunt us. "My yoke is easy," Jesus assures us, "my burden light." As we gather together on this holiday weekend, let us rejoice in the freedom Jesus offers us from our heavy burdens.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: The demands of discipleship are great, but with God's grace they do not become burdensome. After all, our role model, Jesus Christ, is himself meek and humble of heart. Zechariah prophesies that he will come not on a warhorse with force and weapons, but on a beast of burden, offering peace and justice. Paul assures us that God's Spirit dwells in us. Therefore, we can sing in the psalm, "I will praise your name forever." God will lighten our burden.

<u>STEWARDSHIP</u>: We pray that we will be open to the grace to respond to the challenge of stewardship, and that the Holy Spirit, whose gracious action conforms us to Jesus Christ and to the Church, will enlighten us and help us to renew our commitment as the Lord's disciples and as stewards of his bountiful gifts.

<u>A REMINDER:</u> On this Fourth of July weekend, as we celebrate the 244<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the birth of our Country, let us give thanks to God for the freedoms, rights and liberties we enjoy and be mindful of the multitude of sacrifices throughout the years that have been made so that we can continue to be "One Nation Under God."

<u>A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK:</u> When have I realized that my expectations had fooled me? Regarding hardships, what have I learned from asking for help?
