





We gather today, as we do each weekend, as the Body of Christ. Together we pray, we worship God, and we are nourished with the Word and the Eucharist to strengthen us on our journey to the kingdom. In today's first reading, the Lord says that "my house shall be called a house of prayer for all peoples." Let us make this gathering of our faith community, this holy space, a home in which all peoples are welcomed to join us in worship and prayer.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: God's grace in the world is boundless and always has been. Isaiah tells the Israelites that foreigners will be brought to God's holy mountain to worship, to pray, and to celebrate. Paul refers to himself as "apostle to the Gentiles," bringing news of God's mercy to all. Jesus heals the daughter of the Canaanite woman who persists in her pursuit of him. Let us listen to God's word and contemplate the boundaries we are called to break down.

<u>STEWARDSHIP</u>: Who is a Christian disciple? One who responds to Christ's call, follows Jesus, and shapes his or her life in imitation of Christ's. Who is a Christian steward? One who receives God's gifts gratefully, cherishes and tends them in a responsible and accountable manner, shares them in justice and love with others, and returns them with increase to the Lord.

<u>A REMINDER:</u> Please keep in your prayers our eight Second graders who are preparing to receive their First Holy Communion at St. Augustine. May their hearts always be filled with joy in receiving Jesus in the Eucharist and may our hearts do as well. Please keep all our children in your prayers as they return to school, that they may remain safe and healthy.

A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK: To what peripheries can I go to serve others? Do I see everyone as potentially eligible for salvation?
