





Today we hear Jesus tell his disciples that he must go to Jerusalem, where he will suffer and be killed and that - guess what? - whoever comes after him must take up his cross and follow him. It must have been quite a shock. This is the first time Jesus told them this. We know what happened nearly two thousand years ago, but the challenge is new for each generation of disciples. Are we willing to take up our crosses? Will we follow? Let our sharing in the Eucharist strengthen us as we take up the cross and follow him.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: When Jeremiah heard the word of the Lord, it burned so fiercely in his heart that he had to proclaim it, even though it brought him derision and reproach. We have the opportunity to hear the word of the Lord every time we celebrate the Eucharist. Does it burn a fire within our hearts? Does it leave us with no choice but to proclaim it? Does it transform our lives? Or have we forgotten it by the time Mass is over? Let us open our hearts today to the word of God.

**STEWARDSHIP:** Stewardship invites us to reexamine suffering. Pope John Paul points out that suffering is transformed by discovering its salvific meaning when united with the suffering of Christ. Jesus invites us to accept voluntarily penance, so that we might become liberated from those obstacles to Christian discipleship which a secularized culture exalting individual gratification places in our way.

<u>A REMINDER</u>: As we continue in this extraordinary time in which we are called to socially distance from one another, let us never forget the spiritual connectedness that binds us together in faith and charity.

<u>A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK:</u> Looking at the way I lead my life, what aspect do I need to deny myself and in what way can I take up my cross and follow him?
