



Dear Friends.

Today we gather in joy to celebrate the holiest and most wonderful of days: Easter Sunday. Jesus, who sacrificed his life on behalf of us all, has been raised from the dead. Alleluia! This is the day that gives meaning to Jesus' suffering and death, and in turn to our own. Suffering and death are not the end. Jesus has led the way to his Father for all eternity. How appropriate that we gather today for the Eucharist. In the Eucharist, we give thanks to the Lord for the ultimate sacrifice he made for our sins. In the Eucharist, we receive his Body and Blood, more closely uniting us with him, now and eternally. Let us celebrate the Eucharist on this blessed day as we are reborn in the Lord.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: Through the gift of God's word, we get to hear how the Resurrection event gradually came to be understood by the early disciples. In the first two readings, Peter and Paul speak of how our life has completely changed because Jesus Christ was raised from the dead. We may receive forgiveness of sins in his name. We now seek what is above, our destiny. We have become a fresh batch of dough in the hands of the Lord. But upon first seeing the empty tomb, neither Mary Magdalene, Peter, nor John understands what happened. However, even then, a glimmer of faith was kindled.

STEWARDSHIP: As Christians we celebrate God's gift of life for us. We are called to open our hearts, to take responsibility for our God-given gifts, and to share the joy of life with others. Then we will experience a new way of life ... Stewardship.

<u>A REMINDER:</u> We welcome our two new members, Jose Alvarez (St. Augustine) and Bella Tucker (St. Anthony) to the living faith of our Communities of Grace. May they find a welcoming home among us.
