



Dear Friends,

Take a look around you as you make yourself at home in God's home. As you entered, did you welcome others as perhaps you yourself were welcomed? Did you see anyone you did not recognize? Did you give them the once over and make a judgment, perhaps in the back of your mind? In today's second reading, James instructs the Christian community to show no partiality in their assembly. He warns them that those they may tend to avoid or ignore may be exactly those whom God chooses for the kingdom. In that spirit, let us always warmly welcome all who join us to worship the Lord.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: Today we hear the story of a miracle in which Jesus performs a healing in a very intimate way. He draws a deaf and mute man away from the crowd, puts his fingers in his ears and, having spat on them, touches his tongue as well. Jesus is here with us in an intimate way as well. He has been just as close to us since we were baptized, when the priest or deacon touched our ears and mouth as well. He is with us as we gather in his name, in his very Body and Blood in the Eucharist we consume, and in each other. Listening to the readings today, let us realize that the One who healed in such a way is intimately close with us too, wherever we are.

<u>STEWARDSHIP</u>: We are all brothers and sisters in Christ, rich and poor, young and old, black and white. As stewards, we are called to serve all God's people. Through our good works and service, we follow Jesus and share His glory.

<u>A REMINDER</u>: This weekend we remember and celebrate our Grandparents. We remember Joachim and Anne, the parents of the Blessed Virgin and grandparents of Jesus, and how their faith, devotion, and love of God was a model.

<u>A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK</u>: When have I failed to be open to Jesus' message? Opening myself to his challenging message, how will I proclaim it by my words and actions?
