



#### Dear Friends,

Today is World Mission Sunday, a day on which we bring to mind the missionaries who preach and live the gospel to those who have not yet heard or understood it. Today also marks the beginning of Pastoral Care Week, in which we recognize those who give spiritual care to those in need. But it is also important to realize that every one of us is called to be both a missionary of the gospel and a giver of pastoral care. As Jesus teaches his disciples in today's Gospel, we are all called to serve.

**THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON:** The theme running through today's readings is service and our Lord's commitment to be the servant of all. Isaiah prophesies about a servant who will suffer and give his life as an offering for sin. The reading from Hebrews reminds us that Jesus was tested in every way, willing to become weak for our sake. In the Gospel, Jesus tells his disciples he came not to be served but to serve. Let today's readings inspire us to serve others as we live out our faith.

**STEWARDSHIP:** Stewardship is a life of service. Jesus asks us to commit ourselves to be good stewards of the gifts entrusted to us, to share our time, our talents, and our treasures as an outward sign of the love and gratitude we have for Him.

<u>A REMINDER:</u> This Sunday we are recognizing our Confirmandi from our two parishes: six from St. Augustine at the 8am Mass and seven from St. Anthony at the 9:30am Mass. Please keep them in your prayers as they prepare to receive the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on Wednesday, May 7, 2025, at 7pm in St. Dominic Church.

<u>A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK:</u> Looking at my life right now, how is Jesus summoning me? How can I be of service in my family, my parish, my community?
