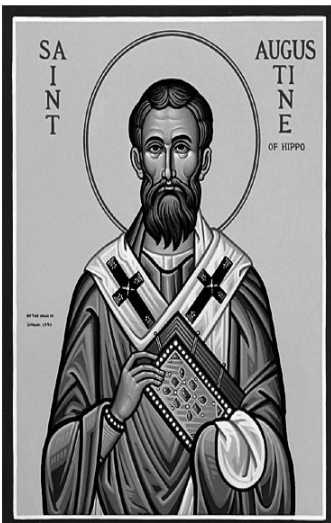

Dear Friends,

On the final Sunday of the Church year, we celebrate Jesus Christ's unique role as ruler over the entire world. He did not become king by conquering other nations, nor by popular acclaim. No, he became king by willingly suffering and dying for our sins and leading us to eternal glory with God. He gave us a glimpse of the kingdom during his earthly life, but we know that he continues to reveal himself in the poor, the weak, and the marginalized; in the Church as we gather in his name; and in the Eucharist we receive and consume each Sunday.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: In today's first reading, we hear Daniel's vision of a Son of man receiving kingship from God over an eternal dominion. As Christians, we understand this prophecy to be fulfilled in Jesus, who often referred to himself as the Son of Man. We also hear a vision from Revelation in which Jesus comes again in glory. The Gospel narrates the scene in which Jesus is questioned by Pilate about his kingship, which he cannot understand. Let us listen to God's word, aware that Jesus came into the world to testify to the truth.

STEWARDSHIP: We serve Christ by opening our hearts and hands to one another. Stewardship calls us to a life of service. This service may take many forms: visiting the elderly, feeding the poor, comforting the sick, welcoming strangers

A REMINDER: As we conclude another Church Year, we celebrate Christ in all His Awesome Majesty and prepare ourselves for the Season of Advent which we begin next weekend. On Tuesday, November 26, we would like to begin a new tradition within our Partnership – *A Service of Praise and Thanksgiving* with the blessing of foods that will be shared around our own individual family gatherings on Thanksgiving Day. The Service will be held this year at St. Anthony at 7pm with Fellowship to follow in their Parish Center. All Are Welcome!

A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK: Have I felt the presence of the kingdom when I have been of service? How can I be of service this week to someone in need?
