Dear Friends,

In our world today, you don't have to look far to see a lack of respect for human life. War, mass shootings, abortion, and capital punishment make a mockery of what should be a basic principle for us all: every life is precious. Let us keep in mind what Saint Paul teaches the Corinthians in the portion of his letter that we hear today: we shall bear the image of Christ in heaven. Every human life is precious if only because every life holds the promise of resurrection and the heavenly image of Christ. We come together today to thank God for all human life and the promise of eternal life.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: Love your enemies, Jesus teaches his disciples. Bless them when they curse you, give more to them when they take from you, turn the other cheek when they strike you. Luke doesn't tell us how the disciples react, but this is a radical teaching. However, we get to see mercy practiced in the first reading, when David chooses to spare his enemy, Saul, when given the chance to slay him. Listening to today's readings, let us consider why we should choose mercy over getting even.

<u>STEWARDSHIP</u>: Stewardship means being a collaborator with God in the work of redemption. A steward acknowledges God's ever-present love. The Spirit of wisdom and courage helps people seek pardon and be mindful in the face of all their forgetting, that the most important work of their lives is to be Jesus' disciples.

<u>A REMINDER</u>: February is the shortest of months but hopefully every day of it was spent growing in grace, knowledge, and service with the Lord.

<u>A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK</u>: Which is the most difficult challenge for me: turning the other cheek when I have been hurt or wronged, refraining from judging others, or giving without repayment? How will I change my thinking and my behavior?
