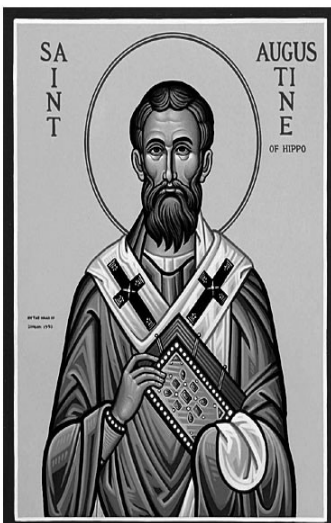

Dear Friends,

We begin the holiest week of the year by holding palm branches in our hands, which recall the palm branches the crowds used two thousand years ago to welcome the Lord into the holy city. Our palm branches are blessed, for they also welcome the Lord to this holy place. Though the people of Jerusalem had no idea what the true nature of Jesus' triumph would soon be, we do and so we anticipate Jesus' ultimate victory while recognizing the intense suffering and profound grief that will accompany it. Let us raise our voices along with our branches as we sing out as even the stones will, "Blessed is the king who comes in the name of the Lord!"

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: We sing some of the saddest words in all of scripture in the psalm today: "My God, my God, why have you abandoned me?" Isaiah resisted this despair as he was struck and spat at, professing his confidence in God. Paul testifies that Jesus was willing to empty himself, to humble himself, accepting even death on a cross. In the Passion, we hear Jesus pray to the Father, "not my will but yours." May today's readings reassure us that even in our worst despair God will never truly abandon us.

STEWARDSHIP: Jesus is the supreme teacher of Christian stewardship, as He is of every other aspect of Christian life; and in Jesus' teaching and life self-emptying is fundamental. Jesus' mission is to restore to good order the created household of God which sin has disrupted. He not only perfectly accomplishes this task, but also, in calling disciples, empowers them to collaborate with Him in the work of redemption for themselves and on behalf of others. By imitating Jesus in His suffering, we will become like Him in His glory.

A REMINDER: The time has arrived, we are now here in Holy Week and with Jesus we walk those final days of his life journey among us before offering himself for our sins. Please see the Partnership Holy Week schedule and consider how you can participate in journeying with Jesus. There is a place in the pew for each of you.

A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK: Who can I forgive with the Lord's mercy this week?

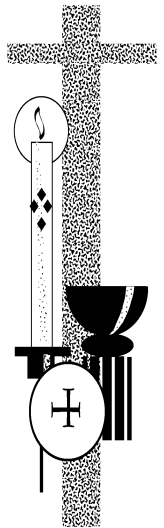
