Dear Friends,

This jubilee year reminds us that we are pilgrims of hope. Our lives are a pilgrimage and the season of Lent is a concentration of that journey. This time of penitence, of sacrifice, and of suffering is our pilgrimage to the cross, the scene and sign of Jesus' greatest sacrifice. But our faith tells us that neither the cross nor death is the end. Therefore, we can be pilgrims of hope, confident that our journeys through Lent and through life will not end in death, but in new life. May our hope for salvation encourage us as we approach the holiest week of the year.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: Even as the Israelites recall their rescue from Eqypt, Isaiah pleads with them to notice that God has rescued them once again, leading them out of the desert of exile. Paul confesses to the Philippians that his faith in the Lord is more important than anything else he has. In the Gospel, Jesus saves the life of the adulterous woman, rescuing her from certain execution and giving her a new chance at life by forgiving her. Truly, as we sing in the psalm, the Lord has done great things for us.

STEWARDSHIP: If we accept God's grace and, repenting, struggle to change, God will respond like the father of the Prodigal Son. "Filled with compassion" at seeing his repentant child approaching after a long and painful separation, this loving parent "ran to his son, embraced him and kissed him" even before the boy could stammer out the words of sorrow he had rehearsed (Lk 15:20). God's love is always there. The spirit of wisdom and courage helps us to seek pardon and to be mindful, in the face of all our forgetting, that the most important work of our lives is to be Jesus' disciples and His faithful stewards.

A REMINDER: As we have entered into April, we know that Spring is not that far behind and that Easter is just two weeks away. Our Lenten Journey is guickly coming to a conclusion. This final full week of Lent is our challenge to tighten up any loose ends in our renewal and reconciliation as we prepare ourselves for Holy Week next week, Our Stations of the Cross this Friday will be at St. Augustine at 7pm with adult faith formation to follow.

A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK: This week, to whom can I extend the mercy that God has extended to me?
