Dear Friends,

As we continue this glorious Easter season, we approach the solemnity of the Ascension, marking Jesus' ascent from this earth to be with the Father in heaven forever. In John's account of the Last Supper, Jesus, knowing that his time here was short, prepared the disciples for the future. He specifically promises to leave them with two gifts; his peace and the Holy Spirit. Let us give thanks for the peace of Christ and the Holy Spirit, two incomparable gifts which nearly two thousand years later we have been given as well.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: Today's readings reel from the practical to the visionary and back again. In the first reading, the original apostles, guided by the Holy Spirit, decide what to require of uncircumcised Gentile converts, of which there were many. Next, we hear another vision of John's from Revelation. Finally, Jesus prepares the apostles for the time after he has ascended to the Father. His message is both practical and visionary. May God's word also enhance our faith in both ways.

STEWARDSHIP: God's greatest gift to us was His Son Jesus. His gift was intentional and sacrificial, expressing His unconditional love for us. As Christians we believe that all we have and all we are comes from God - we are caretakers of His gifts. We can give thanks to God for all He has given us by sharing these gifts out of love for Him and one another.

A REMINDER: On this Memorial Day weekend, we pause to remember all our deceased loved ones, especially those who while serving our Country, gave the ultimate sacrifice of their life in defense of liberty and also those who have returned and are counted among the Wounded Warriors.

A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK: What resentments, jealousies, or ambitions do I have in my heart that interfere with the presence of peace? How can I overcome these?


