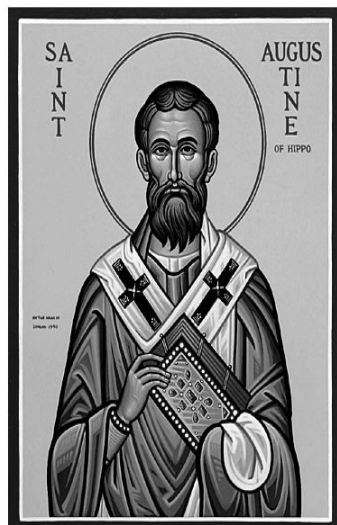

Dear Friends,

Today we hear Jesus describe the relationship of the Holy Trinity. He tells his disciples that everything the Father has is his and that the Holy Spirit would take from what is his and declare it to them. Everything the Father has, the Son has, and the Holy Spirit will reveal it to us. Our Father in heaven provides a model of selfless generosity to our own fathers, whom we honor on this day, as they freely share what they have with their children. Today we praise the Holy Trinity—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit—and their unique, united relationship.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: The first reading and responsorial psalm extol the wonders of God's creation, from the heavens to the earth, from the human race to the beasts of the field to the fishes of the sea. Saint Paul tells the Romans that through the Holy Spirit, God's love has been poured into our hearts. The Holy Spirit, Jesus tells his disciples in the Gospel, glorifies the Son as the Son glorifies the Father. Through the love of God and the wonders of creation, may the Holy Spirit guide us to the Son and the Father.

STEWARDSHIP: Today's responsorial psalm is a steward's response to God's love for humankind that begins with God at work as Creator, Maker of all that is. The steward has a profound reverence for the great gift of life, along with readiness to serve all that preserves and enhances life. Let our love and respect for life reflect God's creative love.
