



Dear Friends,

Today we celebrate the two principal apostles of the early church. Saints Peter and Paul took two completely different routes to their vocation. Peter was called personally by Jesus, traveled with him during his entire ministry, and became the preeminent disciple among the Twelve. Paul, on the other hand, persecuted the early church until he was called and converted by the Risen Lord on his way to arrest Christians in Damascus. May these two saints remind us that God calls us all at different times in our lives and in different ways.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: Because today we celebrate two saints who lived during the time that the New Testament was written, our readings feature significant events from their lives. We hear how Peter is freed from prison by an angel the night before he is to be executed. Paul, knowing that he would soon give his life for his faith, writes a farewell to his close friend and fellow disciple, Timothy. In the Gospel, Peter proclaims Jesus as the Messiah, the Christ. May their strong faith in the Lord be a model for us.

STEWARDSHIP: The parish gives the Church concrete life. It is a home where the members of the Body of Christ gather together, open to meeting God, and ready to accept their brothers and sisters with fraternal love, whatever their condition or origins. It provides the Church's great services: prayer in common and the reading of God's Word, celebrations - especially that of the Eucharist, catechesis for children and the adult catechumenate, the ongoing formation of the faithful, communication designed to make the Christian message known, works of charity and solidarity. It is a community where God's gifts are received and where the baptized generously make their response of faith, hope and love to the call of the Gospel.

<u>A REMINDER</u>: We, again, pause from the "Green" of Ordinary Time to celebrate a Solemnity in the Church of two "pillars" of faith and leadership: Saints Peter and Paul. May the Church under the leadership of its Shepherds continue to grow and bring humanity to Christ. Following the Saturday evening Mass at St. Dominic there will be the Installation of the Breese Knights of Columbus Council Officers.

<u>A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK</u>: How do the examples of Saint Peter and Saint Paul help me respond to my call and give me hope despite my past actions? God bless,


