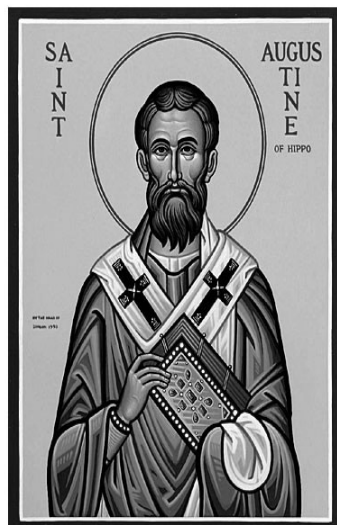

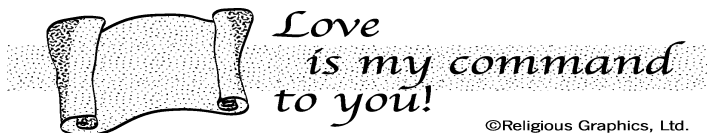

Dear Friends,

Today we hear the story of the good Samaritan, the parable that Jesus told to explain how far-reaching the concept of *neighbor* is and how to show love to our neighbor in need. Remember, Samaritans were looked down upon by the Jewish people in that era. If even *Samaritans* were neighbors, then everyone was. If this undesirable Samaritan is the only person willing to minister to this injured man, we should do the same, ministering to anyone in need, no matter how different they are. May we heed this lesson today just as Jesus taught it two thousand years ago.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: Having shared with the Chosen People the commandments that God spoke to him on Sinai, Moses tells them how simple it is to keep them. If they take them to heart, then they only have to act with all their heart. In Jesus' story of the good Samaritan, it is the Samaritan whose heart is moved with compassion and treats the injured man as God commands we must. May we take God's word to heart.

STEWARDSHIP: In the parable of the Good Samaritan, we have an example of stewardship of personal resources used to serve the good of another. Jesus invites us to see everyone in our community, our city, our country, in the world as our neighbor. Stewardship calls on us to put our gifts - our very selves - at the service of others.

A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK: To whom can I become a neighbor? How will I follow my compassionate heart even if my head comes up with a dozen different excuses?
