Dear Friends,

We do not know when, where, or how our Lord will come to us. He could appear as a stranger, as someone in need whom we have never met before. Or maybe we'll encounter Jesus in a dream, while in deep reflection, or in prayer. We are assured of encountering him here and now in a number of ways: as an assembly gathered in his name, in the priest celebrating Mass, in each other, and certainly in the Eucharist, when we receive his Body and Blood. Our readings today remind us that the Lord comes in many ways and we are called to always respond with attention and kindness.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: In the first reading, Abraham and Sarah offer hospitality to three travelers, one of whom foresees a momentous event. For Paul, the momentous event is Christ winning us salvation, salvation that is offered to all. In the Gospel, sisters Martha and Mary offer hospitality to Jesus, but take on different roles while he visits. Let us show God's word hospitality, listening attentively and prayerfully.

STEWARDSHIP: Jesus is the supreme teacher of Christian stewardship, as He is of every other aspect of Christian life. He not only restores to good order the created household of God which sin has disrupted, but also, in calling disciples, commissions and empowers them as stewards of His Church to collaborate with Him in the work of redemption for themselves and on behalf of others.

<u>A Reminder</u>: This weekend I will also be covering St. Dominic. Another ministry I am involved with is saying Mass at the Breese Nursing Home on the 4th and 5th Tuesdays of the month at 10am. Our two parishes have been asked to provide a Lector/ Extraordinary Minister of Communion to assist those Tuesdays, as well (the individual will help to set up the Altar, read the First Reading and Responsorial, say the intercessions [provided] and distribute Communion to residents not at Mass). It is neither time consuming, nor over demanding, but a joy to know you are sharing a time of faith with individuals whose lives have been a witness to faith. <u>Please consider volunteering.</u>

<u>A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK</u>: How am I hospitable to others in need of food or rest, or just some companionship? How can I see the Lord in such hospitality?

Vocations Spotlight:

"The countless gravestones at Normandy American Cemetery in France stirred my heart. These brave soldiers who sacrificed their lives challenged me: Would I be willing to lay down my life, as these men did, for the Lord and his people? Long before this pivotal moment, the seeds of my vocation had been planted by family role models. My grandfather served his family and parish sacrificially for many years after his WWII duty. Likewise, my father coached me in self-discipline, and my dear mother raised me to serve others. It was at college that the Lord Jesus truly captured my heart. After graduation, I served as a missionary and met the Brotherhood of Hope. I admired the brothers and their work evangelizing students at secular universities, but I resisted the idea of celibacy and did not have the courage to explore a vocation with them until after my experience at Normandy Beach. My years with the Brothers of Hope have strengthened my conviction that Jesus Christ alone can satisfy our deepest desires."
