Today's second reading speaks of a great cloud of witnesses, perhaps referring to the large number of Christians who gave witness to their faith through their words and actions. Baptized in the Lord, we are those witnesses now. Looking around and seeing our faith community gathered here today, let us think of ourselves as a "great cloud of witnesses," assured of each other's support and encouragement as we live out our discipleship to the Lord.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: Today's readings are difficult to hear. Jeremiah's preaching so inflamed the people of Judah that he was thrown into a pit to die. Jesus warned his disciples that he came to inflame people so much that parents would turn against their children and vice versa. Nevertheless, says the author of Hebrews, we must persevere in our faith, endure our cross, and resist sin, so that one day we may find the joy that lies before us. As we suffer hardships on our journey to the Lord, may God's word encourage us to never give up.

STEWARDSHIP: Today, the encumbrance of sin includes not just the quest for pleasure but avarice, a craving for the illusion of absolute dominion and control, valuing creatures without reference to their Creator, excessive individualism, and ultimately the fear of death unrelieved by hope for eternal life. But if we accept God's grace and, repenting, struggle to change, the Spirit of wisdom and courage will help us seek pardon and be mindful that the most important work of our lives is to be Jesus' disciples.

A REMINDER: This week we begin the altered weekday Mass schedule for our two Parishes: St. Augustine Masses will be on Monday and Wednesday at 8am and St. Anthony Masses will be on Tuesday and Friday at 7:30am. There will be a weekly All-School Mass at Mater Dei at 10:18am to which all are invited, as well. And on the Fourth and Fifth Tuesdays I say Mass at the Breese Nursing Home at 10am, to which you are always invited to attend, as well.
