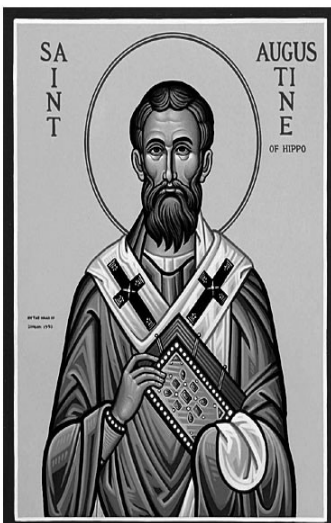

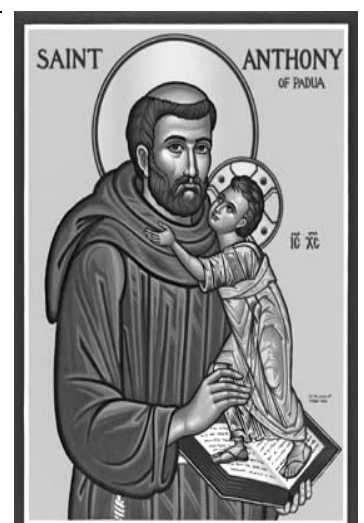

Dear Friends,

"You can't take it with you." It's a reminder that the wealth we accumulate in this world does not transfer to the next. In our secular society, this saying often implies that you should spend your wealth now while you can enjoy it, but our faith demands that we look at wealth differently. Building up material wealth is irrelevant to our vocation as disciples and can distract us from what is truly important. Let us lift our hearts and raise our voices to God, who is the source of our true wealth.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: "Vanity of vanities," we hear right off the bat today, a condemnation of our inclination to labor and obsess over the many material goods we have or hope to accumulate. In the Gospel, Jesus invites us to listen to a parable that addresses this pointless avarice. We get to hear the surprise awaiting the rich man whose harvest was so huge his barns couldn't hold it. In between, we hear Saint Paul's advice to the Colossians: "seek what is above." It's too late for the rich man in Jesus' parable, but it's always timely advice for us.

STEWARDSHIP: Today's readings are a lesson in priorities. Unless God is the first priority in our life, all we do we do in vain. Mature disciples make a conscious, firm decision, carried out in action, to be followers of Jesus Christ no matter the cost to themselves. Beginning in conversion, change of mind and heart, this commitment is expressed not in a single action, nor even in a number of actions over a period of time, but in an entire way of life. It means committing one's very self to the Lord. This is the foundation of Stewardship.

A REMINDER: Please welcome and show a warm hospitality this weekend, as Presider for the Masses at both Parishes, Fr. Francis Tambala, newly arrived in our diocese from Malawi. He is currently staying at Freeburg before being assigned. He will be covering not only our two parishes this weekend, but also St. Dominic, so his time will be limited between Masses. I will be in Washington DC attending the Supreme Knights of Columbus Convention which is covered by EWTN – you might see me! Men's COR meeting on Saturday, August 9th at Mater Dei from 8-9:30am – all men are welcome.

A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK: What or whom have I thought of when I have received an unexpected bounty? How can I be a more generous person?

"My family taught me the value of sacrifice. As I grew up, watching Mom give of herself to raise us boys and Dad lay down his life to provide for our needs, I observed that true love is sacrificial love. When I left home at 18 to work, I chose to continue to practice my Catholic faith. In addition to attending Sunday Mass, I decided to read sacred Scripture and pray the rosary regularly. Eventually, this led to the discipline of going to daily Mass. That was when I started to fall in love with Jesus in the Eucharist. Over the next several years, my heart began to revolve around Our Lord. Though I desired to be married and raise a family, I wanted more than anything to fulfill the Father's will. The stage was thus set for the call to the priesthood I received at the age of 28. Though the sacrifice of leaving human ambitions behind was tough, I responded out of love."
