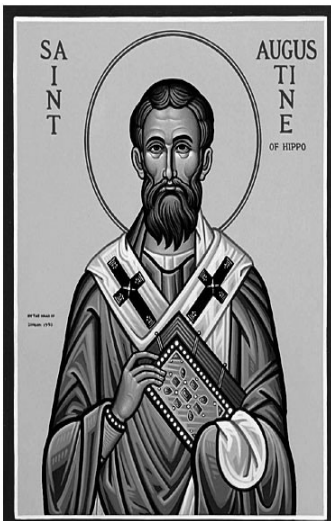

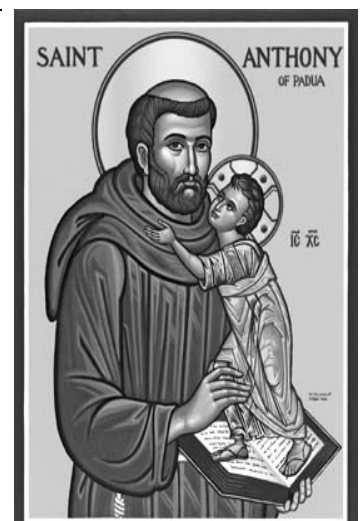

Dear Friends,

Many athletes can tell you how important stamina is to their success. In the closing minutes of a game, it can often come down to who still has the energy to do their best. Often our faith requires stamina as well. Beaten down by tragedies and disappointments, is our faith strong enough to enable us to persist in loving God and loving neighbor, to pursue justice and peace, to continue to build the kingdom? May hope, which we celebrate this Jubilee Year, sustain our stamina to the end of our days.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: The first reading transports us back to Moses' time, to a battle in which Moses' stamina was gravely tested. In the second reading, Paul encourages Timothy to be persistent in spreading the Good News. In the Gospel, Jesus teaches his disciples the importance of praying persistently, to keep their faith while continually petitioning God for justice. May we take to heart the words we sing in the psalm today: "Our help is from the Lord."

STEWARDSHIP: It does not require great faith to share material resources with others and with your parish when you are certain there is enough money for family needs and wants. However, it takes a person of deep faith to give when financial resources are uncertain. Yet God promises that He will never be outdone in generosity.

A REMINDER: This weekend on Sunday at both parishes we will be Commissioning those Eighth graders who are preparing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation on Wednesday, May 6, 2026, at St. Dominic (seven from St. Augustine and seven from St. Anthony. Please keep them, their families, and their Catechists in your prayers as they journey together in faith.

A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK: As this is the Jubilee Year of Hope, can I remain hopeful that God will address my needs and use that hope to help me persist in prayer? Can I promise to do so for ten minutes each day this week?

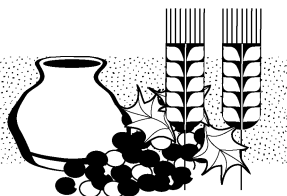
