

Dear Friends,

On Gaudete Sunday we rejoice, for we know that the Lord is near. With eyes of faith, we can sense his presence even as we prepare for the celebration of his coming to us as a newborn infant. With eyes of faith, we can see his coming as well as the prophet Isaiah or the New Testament prophet John the Baptist, who each prepared his people for God's transformative presence. With eyes of faith, let us glory in Jesus' presence right here, right now: in God's word, in the Eucharist, and in those around us.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: The powerful imagery in Isaiah's poetry overwhelms us with joy on this Gaudete Sunday. Deserts bloom with abundant flowers! Parched land exults in joyful song! The blind will see, the deaf will hear, and those who cannot walk will leap like a stag! In this season of watchful preparation for the Lord's coming into our lives, may we recognize his transformative presence in our world as we long for the coming of the kingdom, when all this and more will be fulfilled.

STEWARDSHIP: Jesus identified Himself to John the Baptizer by His stewardship: " ... the blind recover their sight, the cripples walk, lepers are cured, the deaf hear, dead men are raised to life, and the poor have the good news preached to them." As Christian stewards, we are called to receive God's gifts gratefully, cultivate them responsibly, share them lovingly in justice with others, and return them with increase to the Lord.

<u>A REMINDER:</u> On this Advent weekend of "JOY" in anticipation of the Birth of Jesus at Christmas, may our hearts always overflow with a joyful spirit. Our Youth Faith Formation students will be attending their Advent Reconciliation Service on Wednesday, December 17th in St. Dominic Church at 6:45pm.
