Dear Friends,

On the Sunday after Christmas, we honor the Holy Family and hold them up as a model for our own families. From the start, Jesus, Mary, and Joseph had to deal with hardships, uncertainty, and even danger. But together they placed their trust in God and grew ever stronger in their bond with each other. We too are called to trust in the Lord as we face the trials and difficulties of our own lives. As we continue our Christmas celebration, may our families be consecrated in the love of the Holy Family.

<u>THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON</u>: Today's readings offer a number of lessons about family life. Ben Sira shares his wisdom about children's responsibilities to their parents, particularly as their parents age. Saint Paul's advice to the Colossians about how to treat each other teaches us well how to treat members of our own families. The Holy Family places their trust in the Lord as they fear for their safety in dangerous circumstances. May today's readings encourage us as we seek God's blessings upon families of every kind.

STEWARDSHIP: The activity of giving grows out of an attitude of gratitude. After Jesus, it is the Blessed Virgin Mary who by her example most perfectly teaches the meaning of discipleship and stewardship in their fullest sense. All of their essential elements are found in her life: she was called and gifted by God; she responded generously, creatively, and prudently; she understood her divinely assigned role as "handmaid" in terms of service and fidelity. Joseph's life also reflects an obedience to God's will. Does our attitude of gratitude show in the way in which we use our time, our talent, and our treasure?

<u>A REMINDER:</u> This weekend we celebrate not only the "Holy Family" but also the "holiness of our own families. May the old saying, "The family that prays together, stays together" with an addition "and plays together" enhance the love and spiritual strength of our parish families. Also, on Thursday we welcome a "New Year" 2026. May it be a Year of Grace and Favor for all of you.

A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK: As this tumultuous year comes to an end, what can I do for those who are strangers in a strange land?


