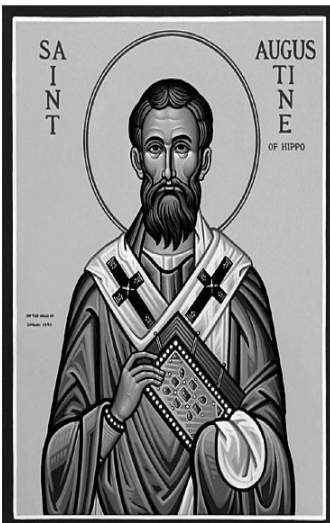

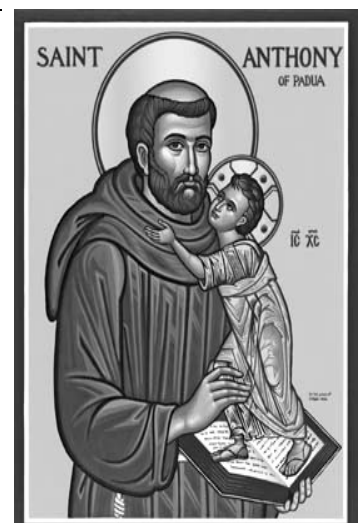

Dear Friends,

As we approach Holy Week and the final days of Lent, we hear the well-known story of Lazarus, the brother of Martha and Mary, whom Jesus raises from the dead. John's account of this miracle is one of the most dramatic accounts in any of the Gospels, save Jesus' own passion, death, and resurrection. We can only imagine the emotions coursing through Martha and Mary and their loved ones when Jesus stands at the tomb and dramatically cries: "Lazarus, come out!" On this final scrutiny Sunday, may we hear Jesus calling out to us as well, to come out of our tombs of sin and death and embrace new life in the resurrection.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: From the first reading to the Gospel, new life is promised for those who believe. Through Ezekiel, God promises the Israelites that one day they will rise from their graves and have God's spirit put in them. Saint Paul proclaims that God will give life to our mortal bodies through the Holy Spirit dwelling in us. Jesus calls Lazarus forth from the tomb, giving new life to his friend after he had been dead for four days. May God's word affirm and strengthen our faith in the Lord's power to give new life.

STEWARDSHIP: The life of a Christian steward, lived in imitation of Christ, is challenging, even difficult in many ways; but both here and hereafter it is charged with intense joy. For Jesus' sake, we must put aside the craving for domination, possession and control and recognize that all temporal and spiritual goods are created by and come from God. All those who seek to live in this way learn that "all things work for good for those who love God." (Rom 8, 28)

A REMINDER: In the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults, on the Fifth Sunday of Lent, we celebrate the Third Scrutiny (again, the scrutinies are intended to complete the conversion of the Elect) and the "Handing on of the Lord's Prayer" with our two Elect. Let us all deeply meditate and contemplate the words of that "perfect prayer."

A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK: What sins are keeping me entombed, isolated from God's love and from others? What can I do to free myself from my tomb?

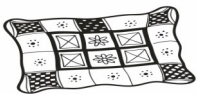
