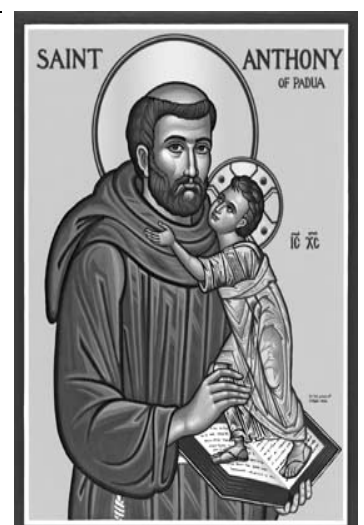
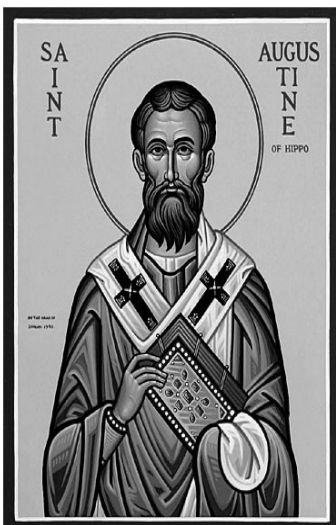

Dear Friends,

In today's Gospel, Jesus assures his disciples that his heavenly Father will watch over them so vigilantly that every last hair on their heads will be accounted for. On Father's Day, let us celebrate our fathers and father figures who watch over us, guide us, and do their best to make sure that not a hair on our heads will be harmed. Happy Father's Day to all the Dads of our two parishes.

**THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON:** Last Sunday we heard Jesus choose the disciples whom he would send out to proclaim the kingdom of God. Today he calls upon them to go out and proclaim it from the housetops. But Jeremiah sets the tone for Jesus' instructions when he confesses his fear of those who would persecute him. Jesus reassures his disciples as Jeremiah reassures himself, that God will protect those who carry out the Lord's work. May God's word build our confidence in God's care and fidelity.

**STEWARDSHIP:** The stewardship of disciples is not reducible only to one task or another. It involves embracing, cultivating, enjoying, sharing and sometimes also giving up the goods of human life. Christians live this way in the confidence that comes from faith: for they know that the human goods they cherish and cultivate will be perfected and they themselves will be fulfilled in that kingdom, already present, which Christ will bring to perfection and one day hand over to the Father.

**A REMINDER:** Summer is well underway and vacation time is on the minds of many. But there is one place we need not take a vacation from, and that is Church. We need the strength of the Word and Sacrament to sustain us in all that we do, whether it be work or leisure. After all, God never takes a break from us! I will be on Retreat this week from Monday through Friday, so there will be no weekday Masses at either parish.

**A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK:** What do I fear the most about witnessing to my faith in the light of day? How can I see my failing to stand up for what I believe in as a greater fear?

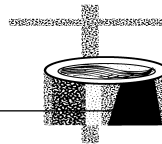

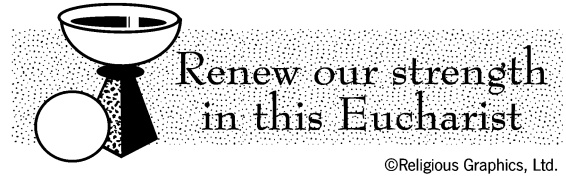
