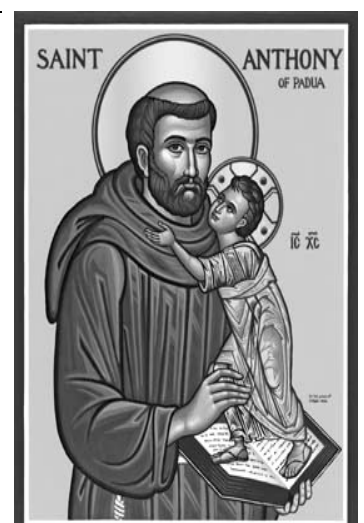
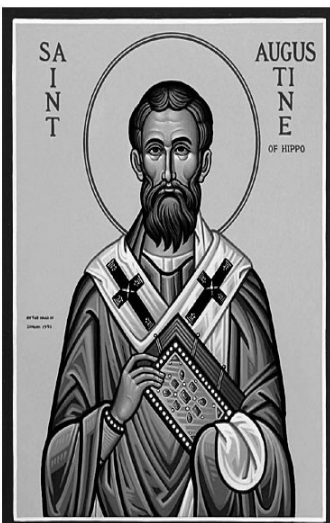

Dear Friends,

Jesus and the prophets teach us how to be generous. A woman in the small village of Shunem regularly invites the prophet Elisha to dine at her home when he passes through town. Eventually, she and her husband arrange a room for him to stay in overnight. Elisha responds to her generosity by promising that she will bear her first son within a year. Jesus tells the apostles that anyone who gives just a cup of cold water to a disciple will be rewarded. Even small acts of human generosity reflect the divine generosity of God. May we all be generous in ways great and small.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: Saint Paul teaches the Romans that the Resurrection means that we may all live in "newness of life." We hear of this newness of life in God's word today. Newness of life is offering generous hospitality to the stranger. Newness of life is expecting a baby. Newness of life is praising the goodness of the Lord. Newness of life is offering a cup of cold water to one of the Lord's disciples. Newness of life is even losing one's life for Jesus' sake. As we listen to scripture, let us listen for how our lives are made new by the Lord.

STEWARDSHIP: The way of the steward is privileged beyond any other, but it is not a way of comfortable living. Christ invites us to put aside the cravings for domination, possession, and control, and to follow Him. Through Jesus, we will come to true liberation and eternal life.

A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK: What metaphorical, "cup of cold water," (some simple thing), can I do for someone, this week and for whom?
