Dear Friends,

In today's Gospel, Jesus challenges us as his disciples to deny ourselves, take up our crosses, and follow him. None of these actions is easy. To put God's will before our own, to willingly accept what will make us suffer, and to follow someone who was put to death on the cross, is very difficult. But we will not be alone, for Jesus is with us as we follow him. Also, as he tells us in the Beatitudes, our reward will be great in heaven. Let us realize his real presence as we celebrate and receive the Eucharist.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: From Jeremiah to Peter, we hear today from those who are willing to rebuke God. Jeremiah accuses the LORD of duping him, of making him an object of derision and mockery. Peter demanded that Jesus stop talking about being killed in Jerusalem. Each expected triumph without cost, accomplishment without the accompanying suffering. We may fall into the same way of thinking. Let us look to Paul, who prays that the Romans be able to discern the will of God. Let us pray that we honestly try to do the same.

STEWARDSHIP: Stewardship invites us to reexamine suffering. Pope John Paul points out that suffering is transformed by discovering its salvific meaning when united with the suffering of Christ. Jesus invites us to accept voluntarily penance, so that we might become liberated from those obstacles to Christian discipleship which a secularized culture exalting individual gratification places in our way.

A REMINDER: I am humbled and honored to have been able to spend the last 25 years of my Priesthood among the parishioners of St. Anthony in Beckemeyer and St. Augustine in Breese. When I first arrived back in August of 2001, I told you I would remain with you (as long as the Diocese or God permitted) and had no plans on retirement – that still stands! I look forward to whatever lies ahead and commit myself to your Pastoral Care.

A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK: When have I been reluctant or unable to resist pressure to conform to society's expectations?

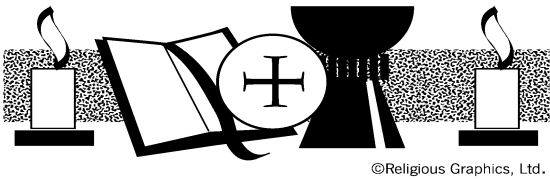

Vocations Corner: "I have a vivid childhood memory of my mom and dad kneeling to pray after receiving Communion. They first taught me how to pray, and their marital witness continues to teach me about fidelity to one's vocation. Years later, at my first Mass, I told my father that I hoped my spiritual fatherhood would reflect his fatherhood – and I still hope for that. I wouldn't be a priest without my parents. Likewise, I wouldn't be a priest without the good men who witnessed to the joy of the priesthood, or the parishioners whose ceaseless prayers and encouragement sustained me. There was also the religious sister who taught me not just calculus, but what it means to leave home and everything behind to follow Jesus. And it was a close friend's offhand remark – "You'd make a good priest" – that sparked a period of serious self-reflection and prayer that led me to the seminary.
