#### Dear Friends,

We are a Eucharistic people, receiving sustenance from the Body and Blood of our Lord in the Eucharist so that we may be sent out as disciples, manifesting the real presence of Jesus in our lives as we build up the body of Christ. In this year of the National Eucharistic Congress, may our appreciation of his real presence in his Body and Blood be revived and may our enthusiasm for the Christian mission be rekindled.

**THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON:** Blood and sacrifice are bonded throughout today's readings. When the Chosen People promise to follow the LORD's commands, Moses sanctifies that vow with the blood of bulls that had been sacrificed to the LORD. The author of Hebrews explains that Christ's sacrificial blood cleanses us of our sins. Jesus, who will soon become the Passover lamb sacrificed for us all, shares a cup of his Blood with his disciples before facing his arrest at the Mount of Olives. Anticipating the sacrificial meal we will share, let us listen to God's word.

**STEWARDSHIP:** Christians bring to the Eucharist their lives as disciples of Jesus and the stewardship they have exercised regarding them and their individual contributions to the great work of Christ. The Eucharist is not only the promise but the commencement of the heavenly banquet which we shall share, enjoying the fruits of stewardship freed of stain, burnished, and transfigured.

**<u>A REMINDER</u>**: In this final Year of the Eucharist, as the Church in the United States prepares for the National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis, July 17-21, 2024; in the Belleville Diocese, we are preparing for the passing through and stopping at the Shrine of Our Lady of the Snows on July 7, of one of the four National Processions of the Eucharist. More information will be shared with you, so that you can plan to attend the diocesan events.

<u>A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK</u>: How does the Eucharist transform me? Thinking back to a time when it was not possible for me to receive the Eucharist, for instance during the pandemic, how did its absence affect me?

#### <u>Parish Update on Priest Replacement and</u> <u>Cluster News:</u>

On April 30<sup>th</sup> there was a Parish Cluster meeting at St. Dominic Annex. The primary discussions were about Priest retirements/replacements and our Parish Family Partnership (Cluster) preparations.

There have been no decisions shared and/or made about a replacement for Fr. Pat. Since there are five Priests retiring on June 30<sup>th</sup> the movement and installment of Priests affects the entire Diocese and has made the Diocesan process more complicated. We will share with Parishioners of all three Parishes the news when the Diocese makes it available to us.

Regarding the Cluster formation and Pastoral Partnership Plan - there has been substantial preparation over the last several years. This preparation includes having established a Partnership Mission Statement, By-Laws and Committees with assigned duties. However, the Parish Partnership Council has decided to stop further preparation until the Diocese informs us of their decisions regarding Priest replacements. It was also decided that our current Mass schedules remain unchanged. These decisions were made to avoid the confusion of making changes and then making additional changes when a new Priest or Priests are assigned. Please Pray for Vocations!
