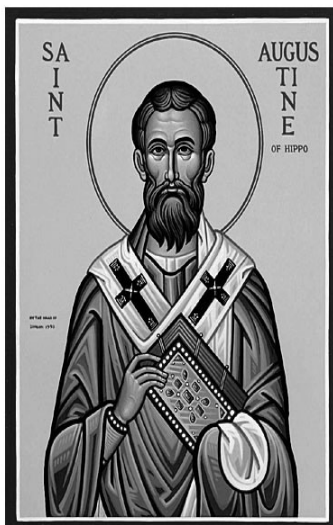

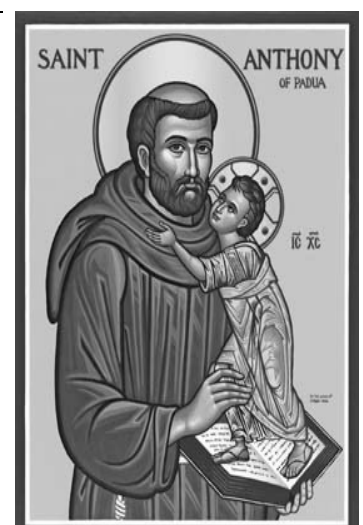

Dear Friends,

Moved by the Holy Spirit, we gather today as a family - a parish family as well as children of God - to celebrate the Eucharist. It is appropriate to think of our family of faith, for in the Gospel today we hear Jesus tell the crowds that whoever does the will of God is a part of his family. We may not always be conscious of our closeness to the Lord, so let us pray that we may come to recognize the gift that allows us to be sisters and brothers of Jesus as we do our best to do God's will.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: Original sin drove a wedge between humanity and God. Adam and Eve were banished from paradise, their home in Eden. But as we sing in the psalm, with God there is mercy and redemption. Indeed, Paul teaches us that while our earthly dwelling - our bodies - may waste away, our heavenly dwelling awaits. In the Gospel, Jesus assures us that whoever follows God's will is brother and sister to him. Let us listen to God's word as part of God's family.

STEWARDSHIP: Stewards are compelled to speak out. .. to proclaim the good news. According to opportunities and circumstances, all Catholics should engage in evangelization personally and on their own initiative. For some, this will mean direct personal participation in mission work; for others, volunteering as PSR catechists who help transmit and strengthen the faith; for others, performing and advocating works of justice and mercy on behalf of persons in need. Like St. Paul, stewards desire to share the gifts and graces they have received from God, especially knowledge of Christ Jesus.

A REMINDER: As I celebrate 50 years of my Priestly Ministry this weekend, it seems like only yesterday that I received my first assignment as the Associate Pastor at St. Mary's Carlyle. The years have gone by quickly but filled with much happiness and a multitude of good memories. I feel blessed to have been called to the Priesthood and to have been able to serve those to whom I was called. These past twenty-three years among you have been a joy-filled experience and as I told you when I arrived in 2001, I will be with you till the Lord decides it's time for me to come home! Thank you for the blessing you continue to be for me in my ministry among you.

A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK: What kind of spiritual workout can I plan for myself? What will I do daily to renew my spiritual self?
